PETERSBURG BOROUGH - BALLOT PROPOSITIONS PROPOSITION NO. 1 Authorization of Electric Utility Revenue Bonds Not to Exceed \$3,315,000 for the Scow Bay Standby Generation Project (Assembly Ordinance #2026-13) Shall the Petersburg Borough incur long-term indebtedness, in a total principal amount not to exceed three million three hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$3,315,000) for the purpose of completing the construction of the Scow Bay Standby Generation Project, including paying incidental costs incurred in connection with carrying out and financing such improvements? The indebtedness would be in the form of electric utility revenue bonds, payable solely from the gross revenues of the electric utility after payment of costs of operation and maintenance, with a term not to exceed twenty (20) years, and would be a revenue obligation solely of the electric utility. A "YES" vote authorizes the issuance of revenue bonds. A "NO" vote does not authorize the issuance of revenue bonds. ☐ YES ☐ NO
