

## **2022 ASSESSMENTS**

Your property has been assessed according to procedures established by State and local regulations. The regular property inspection cycle has remained generally the same during the pandemic, with Borough Contract Assessors doing more of their work remotely. Per PMC 4.24.150, it shall be the duty of every person receiving a notice of assessment to advise the assessor of any error or omission in the assessment of that person's property, in order that the assessor may correct the same.

Any person who receives a notice, or whose name appears on the assessment roll, may appeal to the Board of Equalization with respect to any alleged error in the valuation. If you feel that your property has not been assessed at its full and true value, please complete an appeal form and file it with the finance office prior to the **filing deadline of March 31, 2022 by 4:30 pm** in our office.
