February 27, 2026	Property Assessments Mailed Out
March 1 – March 31, 2026	Appeal Period, deadline 4:30pm March 31st
April 14, 2026	Board of Equalization for unresolved appeals @ 12pm in the Borough Assembly Chambers
July 1, 2026	Property Tax Invoices Mailed
October 15, 2026	Property Taxes Due, 4:30 pm Finance Office

Your property has been assessed according to procedures established by State and local regulations. More information about the process can be found on the Borough's website, in a document titled "Property Assessment and Appeal Guidelines".

Petersburg Municipal Code, section 4.24.150 states that it shall be the duty of every person receiving a notice of assessment to advise the assessor of any error or omission in the assessment of that person's property, in order that the assessor may correct the same.

Any person who receives a notice, or whose name appears on the assessment roll, may appeal to the Board of Equalization with respect to any alleged error in the valuation. If you feel that your property has not been assessed at its full and true value, please complete an appeal form and file it with the finance office prior to the **filing deadline of March 31, 2026 by 4:30 pm in our office.**
