Itinerant Merchant is any person, as defined under section 6.08.010 of the Petersburg municipal code, who temporarily engages in the selling of any kind of goods, wares, merchandise, services, stock and bonds, or other articles within the Borough, regardless of whether peddled from house to house, or sold from any room, building, structure or premises temporarily leased or rented for the purpose of carrying on such business. All merchants will be issued an identification badge to be worn or posted in such a way to be conspicuous at all times while conducting business.
