

## **Home Chlorine Removal**

Some utility customers buy bottled water to avoid chlorinated water. Tap water can be de-chlorinated at home by filling a container (preferably glass) that is lightly covered and leaving it on the counter overnight before putting it in the refrigerator to cool for drinking.

The Petersburg Water Utility routinely monitors for constituents in your drinking water according to Federal and State laws. In 2003 more than 2,300 separate tests were performed on water samples collected from various points within the distribution system and over 5,400 throughout the entire system.
